**NOTICE TO CANADIAN AFFILIATES AND CFTP MEMBER COMPANIES
SIGNATORY TO THE 2009 BRITISH COLUMBIA AND YUKON COUNCIL OF FILM
UNIONS MASTER AGREEMENT**

Re: Call Sheets

The Consultation Committee established under the British Columbia and Yukon Council of Film Unions (“B.C. Council”) Master Agreement met on October 5, 2009. During the meeting, the B.C. Council requested that each Producer forward to the Council copies of call sheets it provides to crew members on productions within the jurisdiction of the B.C. Council. The Producers pointed out that the Master Agreement does not require the Producers to provide call sheets to the Council. Although the Council acknowledged that there is no requirement to provide call sheets, its representatives said it is important for them to receive call sheets so they know where union members are working at any given time.

The Producers expressed concern that distributing call sheets sometimes results in people, who are not crew members, showing up at production sites in order to see particular celebrities. The B.C. Council assured the Producers that access to the Council’s database on which call sheets are kept is limited to a small number of office staff.

Based on the Council’s stated needs and assurances, the Producers have agreed to forward copies of call sheets to the B.C. Council office when such call sheets are provided to the crew members on a production. The B.C. Council will then forward the call sheets only to the appropriate B.C. Council member unions. The B.C. Council member unions will house the call sheets in secure locations.


In reaching this understanding, the parties acknowledged that the Producers’ agreement to furnish call sheets to the Council does not create a contractual mandate to do so. In addition, the parties agreed that a Producer’s failure to provide call sheets is not a grievable matter.

Based on the foregoing, please instruct the appropriate person(s) in your Company to provide copies of call sheets to the B.C. Council when such call sheets are provided to crew members on productions within the B.C. Council’s jurisdiction.
