**NOTICE TO CANADIAN AFFILIATES OF THE AMPTP AND CMPA MEMBER COMPANIES SIGNATORY TO THE 2012 BRITISH COLUMBIA AND YUKON COUNCIL OF FILM UNIONS MASTER AGREEMENT:**

Re: Accident and Near Miss Reports

At the March 14, 2013 meeting of the Consultation Committee established under the British Columbia and Yukon Council of Film Unions ("B.C. Council") Master Agreement, representatives of the B.C. Council raised as a topic of discussion: Accident and Near Miss Reports.

This is a reminder that Article **12.06** (a) of the BC Council of Film Unions' Master Agreement states:

"Producers will copy the applicable Council member-Union(s) with all Workers' Compensation Board Form 7's and Accident/Near Miss Investigation Reports within five (5) days of being provided to WCB."


In addition, subpart (b) of that Article provides:


"(b) Producers shall inform the applicable Council member-Union(s) as soon as reasonably practical when a workplace accident has resulted in an Employee being transported to hospital."

The B.C. Council has indicated that it is typically not receiving the required reports at all or it is receiving them, but not in a timely manner.

Please instruct Production Managers on your Company's productions working within the jurisdiction of the B.C. Council of this requirement under the collective agreement.
